Education And Credentials

Diana Hermann, L.Ac. earned her Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (MAcOM) degree from the Oregon College of Oriental Medicine in September 1999. In order to obtain this degree, Diana completed a four-academic-year program consisting of 3,100 hours of education, including 954 hours of clinical practice. Her training in Traditional Chinese Medicine included the disciplines of acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine, Oriental massage, and additional non-needle techniques. Diana also completed post-graduate study at The Nanjing University of Traditional Chinese Medicine in Nanjing, People's Republic of China. Her training is ongoing with annual continuing education courses and post-graduate classes.

Diana is nationally certified in Oriental Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM). She is licensed in the State of Colorado as an acupuncturist (#768). Diana has never had any license, registration or certification suspended or revoked.
